This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order dated 09.06.2014 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari whereby an application under Section 156(3) moved by the petitioner for issuance of directions to the police to register the case under Section 307 IPC and to monitor the investigation in case FIR No. 58 dated 23.03.2014, Police Station Radaur under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC, was dismissed.

On notice, a reply has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1 on 10.09.2014. After registration of the FIR, the investigation has been carried out. A report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been prepared under Section 323/325/506/34 IPC and present in the Court of Illaqa Magistrate on 08.09.2014 and now the case is fixed for 23.09.2014 for further proceedings.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the injuries inflicted by the petitioner is grievous in nature with blunt weapon but not dangerous to life. The investigation is carried out. The trial is now fixed for prosecution evidence. No further orders are required to be passed in the present petition. The petitioner is at liberty to avail all the remedies before the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
