The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 116 dated 30.04.2015, registered under Sections 457/380 IPC at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that recovery was effected from two ladies and name of the petitioner was also given by the complainant and he is sought to be arrested as he has been named by the co-accused.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer and states that name of the petitioner is mentioned in the FIR and the entire recovery has not been effected and it is a gang which is operating and theft has been taken place in number of houses and the petitioner has been named by the co-accused and recovery is to be effected for which custodial interrogation is necessary.

In view of the above, no case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
