2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3, only at this stage.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

4. During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case representations/complaints dated April 23, 2015 and May 02, 2014 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) moved by petitioner is dealt with and dispose of within a stipulated period.

5. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-

Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to enquire into the allegations

unfolded by the petitioner in his representations/complaints dated April 23, 2015 and May 02, 2014 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and in case any substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
