The petitioner has moved to this Court on account of inaction on the part of the police in not registering a case against respondents No. 4 to 9 under Section 306 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code. A complaint was made to the police by the petitioner, copy of which is Annexure P-2, and according to him, police did not take any action and for that reason, he made representation (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka.

The petitioner has approached this Court without knocking the door of the Court below by filing a complaint on account of inaction on the part of the police and, therefore, without first exhausting that remedy he

should not invoke the provisions of Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
