Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.63 dated 21.06.2015 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 342, 506 IPC and 27/30-54-59 Arms Act, Police Station Sector-20, Panchkula and all the consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2-Pankaj Ahuja alleging that the petitioners had assaulted and caused injuries to the complainant. The parties have entered into a compromise. In this context, the statements of the parties have been recorded by Area Magistrate, Panchkula and a report has been forwarded to this Court regarding its satisfaction that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the above and the judgment in ***Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052***, this petition is allowed. The FIR No.63 dated 21.06.2015 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 342, 506 IPC and 27/30-54-59 Arms Act, Police Station Sector-20, Panchkula and all criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the condition that the petitioners will deposit a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with the Haryana State Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within a period of one month.
