Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 166, dated 13.08.2013, for offence punishable under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station, Division No.3, Jalandhar.

This Court, vide order dated 02.07.2015, has granted interim bail to the petitioner, however, subject to his joining the investigation and to comply with the provisions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order dated 02.07.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Kuldeep Singh, also submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, order dated 02.07.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.

However, petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
