SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.58 dated 23.02.2015, under Sections 326, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 02.07.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in respect of occurrence dated 20.02.2015, FIR came to be registered only on 23.02.2015. In FIR No.293 dated 06.11.2014, complainant-party is accused of offence under Section 307 IPC in which petitioner received as many as 13 injuries and the injuries were declared to be dangerous to life. The accused (complainant-party) in the aforesaid case has not been arrested so far and precisely for that reason CRM-M No.5997 of 2015 is pending in this Court.

Learned counsel further states that in the present FIR, part attributed to petitioner is a kirpan blow which was ultimately landed on the left hand arm above wrist of the complainant and that injury is on non-vital part of the body. All other co-accused have been granted anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion for 24.08.2015.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 30.07.2015 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head Constable Satnam Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 02.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
