This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 135 of the Indian Electricity Act at Police Station APT, Ludhiana, vide FIR No.417 dated 29.8.2012.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 30.01.2015, entire amount of penalty and compounding charges have been deposited with the Electricity Department.

Aforesaid contention is not disputed by the learned State counsel. He further submits that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required by the investigating agency.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 30.01.2015 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed in aforesaid terms.
