RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.42 dated 26.05.2015 under Sections 308, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh, Police Station Bareta, District Mansa, submits that although petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for the purpose of any further investigation, injury on the person of the injured was a grievous one which has been found to be dangerous to life.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no allegation against the petitioner of misuse of concession of interim anticipatory bail granted by this Court and he is entitled for the concession of anticipatory bail.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and after going through the record of the case, this Court is of the considered opinion that in the given fact situation of the present case, petitioner has been found entitled for the concession of anticipatory bail. It is so said because there is no allegation against the petitioner of any misuse of concession of interim anticipatory bail granted by this Court.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed and the order dated 02.07.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
