Instant petition has been filed by Kuldeep Singh under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 82, dated April 22, 2015 under Sections 379, 411, 420, 468, 471, 413 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City-I, Abohar, District Fazilka.

2. Instant case has been registered at the instance of Amandeep Singh who has unfolded that he purchased one motorcycle make Hero Honda CD Delux bearing registration No. PB-05-P-4083 from Kuldeep Singh for an amount of ₹23500/-. The registration of the said motorcycle was in the name of Piara Singh son of Phussa Ram and forms No. 29 and 30 were got completed from the office of DTO Sri Muktsar Sahib and motorcycle was transferred in his name on July 22, 2013. When he (complainant) visited his relatives at Abohar, Kuldeep Singh again met him alongwith one person and disclosed that they want to sell two motorcycles and they will prepare the documents of the said vehicles. On

suspicion, he (complainant) again inquired the registration of his motorcycle and came to know that alleged motorcycle purchased by him was a stolen property.

3. As per the case of prosecution, during interrogation five more motorcycles have been recovered from his custody. However, learned State counsel has categorically stated that no other case is pending or disposed of against petitioner of this nature. Petitioner was arrested in this case on April 22, 2015. He was subjected to custodial interrogation. Since, petitioner is in judicial lock up, his further custodial interrogation is not required and presentation of challan is likely to take sufficient long time, especially in view of the fact that co-accused of petitioner are at large.

4. Taking into consideration all the above-said facts and without expressing any opinion on merits of case, this Court deems it a fit case to extend the concession of bail to petitioner. Accordingly, instant petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail at the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
