SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.170 dated 28.10.2014, under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

As per the prosecution case, petitioner told the complainant party that he would get their sons employed in the Army and in this regard, he demanded ₹2,50,000/- per person. In all, complainant party had paid ₹6,00,000/- to the accused. However, sons of the complainants were neither provided jobs nor the amount in question was returned to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner has been falsely involved in this case.

In the present case, allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature. As per the prosecution case, petitioner took ₹6,00,000/- from the complainants for providing appointment to their sons in the Army and had failed to do so nor had returned the amount in question to the complainants.

Petitioner might be required for custodial interrogation.
