Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.376 dated 19.06.2015, under Sections 279, 337, 323, 325, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector 5, District Gurgaon.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 02.07.2015:-

“Notice of motion to the respondent be issued for 24.08.2015.

Mr. G.C. Shahpuri, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the complainant and files vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

In the meantime, the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed subject to the following conditions:

(i) He shall make himself available for investigation as and when required to do so.

(ii) He will not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.

(iii) He will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police official.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Ashok Kumar has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 02.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
