By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case, FIR No. 434 dated 08.10.2014, registered under Sections 4A/8, 2/80 of the Cow Slaughtering Act, 1955, at Police Station Punhana, District Mewat.

The learned counsel contends that the petitioners were not arrested from the spot. The petitioners deal in sale and purchase of cattle. In pursuance of the order dated 27.01.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that

in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 27.01.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
