5. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-

Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to enquire into the allegations

unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated May 15, 2015 (Annexure P-3) and in case any substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
