Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition to enable the petitioner to take up all the plea, available to him, before the trial Court.

However, in case, petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within 15 days from today, thereafter, her personal appearance before the trial Court shall remain exempted subject to following conditions:-

- i. petitioner shall be represented through counsel;
- ii. shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii. shall not dispute her identity as an accused;
- iv. shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in her absence but in the presence of her counsel;
- v. shall appear before the Trial Court as and when

required by the Trial Court;
vi. any other condition which the learned Trial Court may
impose.
