LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in FIR No. 310 dated 11.09.2013 registered under Sections 307/387/34 IPC and 25/54/59 Arms Act at Police Station Old Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Ramesh Chander, submits that out of 27 prosecution witnesses, 16 have been examined. Only 4 other prosecution witnesses remain to be examined. The others have been given up. The next date of hearing before the trial Court is 13.02.2015.

Keeping in view the stage of the trial, I do not find it expedient to extend the benefit of bail pending trial to the petitioner at this stage.

All the four remaining prosecution witnesses are official witnesses and it is assured that they shall testify before the Court on the next date of hearing i.e. 13.02.2015.

Therefore, no ground is made out to extend the benefit of bail pending trial to the petitioner at this stage. However, the trial Court shall make all efforts to expedite the trial.

Dismissed at this stage.
