ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.71 dated 19.05.2015, registered under Section 347 IPC (Section 363 and 366 IPC added subsequently), Police Station Marinda, District Ropar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it was a run away marriage and the prosecutrix was present in the Court and she has made a statement to the police that she wanted to live with her husband. He states that the prosecutrix is carrying a child.

A perusal of the record shows that the victim and the petitioner had approached the SSP, Ropar for protection. Victim was major. The State counsel states that the girl had made a favourable statement in favour of the petitioner.

In view of this anticipatory bail is allowed to the petitioner subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
