Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 51, dated 05.06.2015, under Sections 354, 323 of the Indian Penal Code and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Baretta, District Mansa.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 06.07.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from ASI Darshan Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 06.07.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
