Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case Criminal Complaint No.322/1, dated 18.11.2009/01.07.2013, under Sections 302/218/467/468/471/342/120-B IPC, pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hodal.

On 03.07.2015, learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner has been summoned in the complaint case and he has been found innocent during the police investigation.

Vide order dated 03.07.2015, this Court has directed that in the event of appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court, he shall

be admitted on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 03.07.2015, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and the trial Court on 08.07.2015 has admitted him on bail subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds.

Mr. Bijender Dhankar, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1 and does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 03.07.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

It is made clear that expression made here-in-above shall not be construed, as an expression on the merit of the case and the trial Court shall be at liberty to decide the case on the basis of available evidence.
