Petitioner is alleged to have given superficial burn injuries and blisters by throwing hot melted ghee on the persons of Parampreet Singh @ Preet and Jasanpreet Singh and also on the person of grand mother of the aforesaid minors when she went to save them.

Initially, FIR was registered under Section 324/323 IPC in which petitioner was granted bail. Subsequently, on 16.12.2014, offence under Section 326-A IPC was added on the opinion of Doctor and the petitioner was arrested on the said date i.e 16.12.2014. Petitioner is maternal aunt of father of complainant. It has been alleged that she is not mentally sound as her husband is suffering from sugar and he is 100% blind. Petitioner is living under depression.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harphool Singh submits that challan has already been presented. Charges have been framed and 4 prosecution witnesses out 20 witnesses

have been examined. Petitioner is in custody since 16.12.2014.

Taking into totality of facts and circumstances, petitioner can be granted regular bail being lady. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
