Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.294 dated 24.04.2015, under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 506 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 03.07.2015:-

"It is inter alia contended that in a case filed under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, the protection officer has given the report in favour of petitioner. It is further contended that all the dowry articles have since been recovered and were lying in the police station.

Notice of motion for 29.09.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail by the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as enshrined in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to file a copy of report of the protection officer by the next date of hearing."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Inspector Satish Kumar has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 03.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
