Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 CrPC is for issuance of directions to the respondent-authorities not to harass and humiliate the petitioner and not to pressurize the petitioner and his family members for entering into a compromise in RSA No.993 of 2014 pending between the petitioner and respondents no.8 to 10.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Darshal Lal, HPS, DSP (HQ), Sonipat, on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3, para 25 of which reads as under:-

“That the contents of para no.25 of the petitioner are wrong and hence denied. The FIR in question as already been investigated properly and report u/s 173(2) Cr.P.C. has also been submitted in the Court of Ld. Illaqa Magistrate, Sonipat.”

Considering the fact that the police has already investigated the matter and report under Section 173 CrPC has also been submitted in the Court of Illaqa Magistrate, Sonapat, no further action is required in this case, as there is no FIR pending against the petitioner.

The petition is disposed of.
