This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.97 dated 30.05.2015 registered at Police Station Mullana, District Ambala for offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC.

Heard.

The FIR in the case was registered on the complaint of Pawan Kumar where in he alleged that the petitioner on the pretext of arranging a service for him in Health Department Haryana took ₹3,00,000/-. The petitioner could not arrange any job for the complainant and when the complainant demanded his money back he was given a cheque of ₹50,000/- drawn on Bank of Broda, which when presented was dishonoured. The petitioner was arrested in this case on 07.06.2015. Challan in this case has been presented by the police.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner-Jitender Sharma is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ambala subject to following terms:-

1. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
2. In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh before the trial Court.
3. He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
