The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.194 dated 13.12.2014 under Sections 406/498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner having argued the matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the petition. He, however, raises an additional submission that the petitioner would surrender within one week and if thereafter, an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail is filed, directions be issued for deciding such application on the same very day.

As per submission made by counsel appearing for the petitioner, petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner surrenders within a period of one week from today and thereafter files an application seeking regular bail, the same would be considered

strictly on merits and the competent Court would make an earnest endeavor to expedite the hearing and disposal of the same.
