HARI PAL VERMA J. (Oral):

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 CrPC is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in complaint No.39 dated 12.2.2009 under Sections 420/406/506/120-B/34 IPC pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that Section 420 IPC stands deleted and the petitioner has been summoned only under Sections 406/506 IPC. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 24.4.2015 in a complaint case and all the offences are triable by a Magistrate.

Considering the fact that it being a complaint case, which is triable by a Magistrate and the petitioner is in custody since 24.4.2015, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered

to be admitted to bail, subject to his furnishing of bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Needless to say that, nothing observed here-in-above shall reflect on the merits of the main case, in any manner, as the same has been so recorded for a limited purpose of deciding the present petition for regular bail.
