AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.265 dated 06.05.2015 registered under Sections 419/420/467/468/471/120-B and 506 IPC at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner states that the worst case against the petitioner is that she has obtained Rs.12,44,000/- and the

petitioner would have no objection in depositing this amount in Court in the form of fixed deposit and the same may be handed over to the party whosoever is found entitled at the time of conclusion of the case but the petitioner should be granted bail.

Learned counsel for the complainant and learned Assistant Advocate General state that if this deposit is made they would have no objection to the grant of bail to the petitioner.

In the circumstances, the prayer is conditionally allowed and it is directed that in case the petitioner deposits a sum of Rs.12,44,000/- in Court she would be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court and the amount so deposited would be put as fixed deposit in the name of the Court in any nationalized bank and the same be handed over to the party found entitled thereto at the time of conclusion of the case.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
