The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.163, dated 1.11.2014, registered under Sections 302, 307, 34 of the IPC, at Police Station Division No.3, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the allegations against the petitioner do not show that he is guilty of murder and apart from the merits of the case, he has now been in custody for more than one year and that the main accused has been declared as a proclaimed offender.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, has accepted the factual submissions that the main accused is Dinesh

and the allegation against the petitioner is only of helping Dinesh.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
