M.M.S. BEDI, J (ORAL)

The petitioners claim that their son, Gurpreet Singh, has married the daughter of respondents No.4 and 5 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 8 and on account of said circumstance, the petitioners are not permitted to enter their house by the private respondents.

Through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek direction to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty.

On asking of the Court, counsel for the petitioners informs that the son of the petitioners at present is residing at Ludhiana along with the daughter of respondents No.4 & 5 and that the petitioners are presently residing in their house in Amritsar which is near the house of respondents No.4 and 5. The petitioners appear to have submitted a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. Copy of the representation is placed on record as Annexure P-5.

The reply filed by the official respondents indicates that they have not received any application, however, it has been assured that in case of any imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, necessary steps would

be taken, if required.

Learned counsel appearing for the private respondents states that they have neither interfered in the life and liberty of the petitioners nor have any such intention to do so.

In view of the said circumstances, this petition is disposed of with an observation that it will be open to the petitioners to seek any legal remedy or seek injunction. In case of any imminent threat to their life and liberty, it will be open to the petitioners to approach the official respondents expecting that necessary steps will be taken to ensure maintenance of peace in the society.
