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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Pursuant to the order dated 27.11.2014, passed by this Court, the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Fatehgarh Sahib, received. The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Fatehgarh Sahib, has reported that the parties have effected compromise of their free will and that the compromise is valid one.

A perusal of FIR in question shows that it was a matrimonial dispute between the parties. Since the same has been amicably settled, therefore, FIR No. 2 dated 3.1.2014, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Mulerpur, District Fatehgarh Sahib, alongwith consequential proceedings stand quashed.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
