Report dated 18.08.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar has been received, whereby, after recording statement of petitioner Manjit Singh @ Monu as well as of complainant Som Nath @ Sonu and Balwinder Pal @ Bindi it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

In view thereof and keeping in view that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.32 dated 25.04.2010 under Sections 323,324,326,34 IPC, Police Station, Lambra, District Jalandhar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
