Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.40 dated 27.5.2014 under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Talwandi Chaudhrian, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 6.7.2015, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and the trial Court has granted him interim bail, on his furnishing of bail bonds for a sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Balkar Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and the trial Court has granted him interim bail, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 6.7.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.
