This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.58 dated 31.08.2010 registered at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot for offences punishable under Section 379, 436, 447, 427 read with Sections 149 & 120-B IPC.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on 20.04.2015 when the case was fixed before the trial Court the petitioner could not appear during the pre-lunch session when the case was called and his bail bond and surety bond was cancelled. However, he appeared in the second session and was taken into custody.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has absented on earlier two occasions.

Keeping in view the facts that the petitioner had appeared in the Court on the date fixed and is in custody since 20.04.2015, but without

commenting anything on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner-Gurjit Singh @ Gopi is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot subject to following terms:-

1. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
2. In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh before the trial Court.
3. He shall not leave the country without previous permission of the Court.
