RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(Oral)

Petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.160 dated 09.04.2015 under Sections 452, 324, 506 IPC and under Section 25 of Arms Act. Offence under Section 307 IPC was subsequently altered to Section 326 IPC, Police Station, Gannaur, District Sonapat. Learned counsel states that medicolegal report was initially prepared by private hospital and thereafter injured was referred to PGI, MS, Rohtak. As per MLR prepared by private hospital, 4 injuries were shown on the person of injured-Lokesh. Injury No.4 which is incised wound of 2x1/2 c.m. on the left upper arm is found to be grievous. According to Mr. Yashwinder Singh, DAG, Haryana, on instructions from ASI, Suresh Chander, there is no

fracture underneath this injury. Challan has already been presented and now the case is fixed for 16.07.2015 for framing of charge. Petitioner is in custody since 09.04.2015 and is no more required for any investigation of the case.

In view of filing of challan, it would be debatable as to whether injury no.4 on the left arm of the complainant is sufficient to attract culpability under Section 326 IPC, particularly, in view of no fracture found underneath this injury.

Without commenting upon anything on merits, petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM, Sonapat.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
