Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC to the petitioner-Pardeep Kumar in case FIR No.149 dated 26.7.2014 for offence punishable under Section 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Sadar, Patiala.

As per allegations, the petitioner after being apprehended along with two other co-accused riding on a motor cycle from where 850 Capsules were recovered, further led the investigating agency to recover 1200 Psychotropic Tablets which upon weighing were found to be of 67 grams. After the receipt of the Chemical Examiner Report, the quantity has been found to be commercial.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner

seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
