JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.25 dated 16.03.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered with Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran (**Annexure P-1**).

There is a recovery of 300 grams of intoxicating powder, which on receipt of Chemical Examiner Report has been found to be containing 2.80% of *Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride*. The said quantity concededly is commercial in nature.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Sewak Singh, points out that there are four other FIRs pending against the present petitioner/accused. Out of which, two are under the NDPS Act.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
