This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.23 dated 16.01.2015 registered at Police Station City Khanna, District Ludhiana for offences punishable under Sections 406 and 420 read with Section 120-B IPC.

Heard.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the court, Mr. P. S. Ghuman, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court accepts notice and submits that intimation by Registry informing of fixation of the petition has already been received and record of the case is available with him.

Custody certificate filed today in Court by State Counsel, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused of the petitioner, Mulakh Raj has been allowed regular bail in this case vide order dated 29.06.2015 passed by this Court in CRM-M-17782 of 2015 and challan in this case has also been filed.

Keeping in view the above fact and that the challan has already been presented against the petitioner, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner- Gurwinder Singh @ Goldy is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana subject to following terms:-

1. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
2. In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh before the trial Court.
3. He shall not leave the country without previous permission of the Court.
