By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.5, dated 10.01.2013, registered under Sections 307, 326, 324, 452, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is a case of version and cross version. In pursuance of the order dated 07.07.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 07.07.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
