The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeks a direction to official respondents No. 2 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against private respondents No. 5 to 7 for preparing and attesting false pedigree-table and committing fraud and forgery in order to grab the agricultural land in village Gidder, Tehsil Nathana, District Bathinda.

The petitioner claims that he had purchased land measuring 10.5 kanals from Surjit Kaur and after death of Surjit Kaur attempt is being made to claim the land by Apar Singh, her son.

Petitioner claims that he had submitted representation Annexure P-1 for action against Numberdar Kuldeep Singh, Darshan Singh and

Angrej Kaur, employees of D.C. Office, as they are preparing false pedigree-table of Lal Singh. The claim of the petitioner in his Annexure P-1 is that the accused have committed forgery of the land record to cause prejudice to the interests of the shareholders including the petitioner and that now they are bent upon to purchase the land in connivance with other person.

Perusal of Annexure P-1 indicates that prima facie, no cognizable offence is made out. No direction thus can be issued in the present case. However, it is observed that in case the petitioner is able to substantiate the allegations it will be open to the petitioner to approach the competent authority in accordance with law.
