Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.98 dated 04.08.2014, under Sections 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Verowal.

Following order was passed by this Court on 20.07.2015:-

"Learned counsel for the petitioners would contend that the allegations are primarily targeted against co-accused Ashu Arora and who allegedly was entrusted a sum of Rs.4,20,000/- to facilitate the sending of complainant Parminder Singh to a foreign land. It is further submitted that the petitioners are otherwise ready and willing to join investigation.

List on 16.11.2015.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to

join investigation and to appear before the I.O on 25.7.2015 at 11 A.M.

In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and they shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Harjinder Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 20.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
