LISA GILL, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for bail pending trial in FIR No. 94 dated 04.03.2014 registered under Sections 454, 436, 427, 380, 295, 201 IPC at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the above said FIR. It is contended that the petitioner's father Kamruddin had lodged FIR No. 261 dated 10.10.2013 registered under Section 302 IPC against the father of the complainant i.e. Nanak Chand for committing murder of the petitioner's mother. In the present case, no specific date of the alleged incident has been mentioned. The petitioner has been in custody since 23.05.2014. No recovery is to be effected from him. Charges have been framed on 14.01.2015 and the trial is likely to take a long time.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Mohinder Singh, confirms the registration of FIR No. 261 dated 10.10.2013 by the petitioner's father.

The petitioner is in custody since 23.05.2014. Charge has been framed against the accused persons. No recovery is to be effected from the petitioner. There are no allegations on behalf of the State that petitioner is likely to abscond or that he is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition.

Consequently, the petitioner shall be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
