Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 87 dated 05.06.2011, under Sections 447, 511, 427, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Division Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Gurmeet Singh alleging that the petitioners along with 2-3 unknown persons had constituted an unlawful assembly and tried to take possession of land belonging to the complainant by interfering with the demarcated stones and damaged the same.

Parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another RCR (Criminal) 1052,** the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
