Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.173 dated 04.07.2011, under Sections 452, 379, 427, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Civil Lines Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

It is submitted that apart from the allegations, the parties have now entered into a compromise and have already filed CRM-M No.20853 of 2015 seeking quashing of the FIR itself on the basis of the compromise.

Learned State Counsel and Counsel for the complainant do not refute the factual position regarding seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise.

In view of the aforesaid subsequent developments, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 17.07.2015, is made absolute.
