This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.271 dated 05.12.2012 registered at Police Station City-I, Abohar, District Fazilka for offences punishable under Section 392, 395, 454 read with Section 120-B IPC.

Co-accused Raghubir Singh @ Rana and Raghubir Singh @ Gora have already been allowed the benefit of regular bail vide order dated 18.02.2014 passed in CRM-M-35984 of 2013 and order dated 05.06.2014 passed in CRM-M-17380 of 2014.

As per the case of the prosecution three persons with muffled faces trespassed the house of the complainant and by showing the gun, they obtained the key of the safe of the almirah and took away gold ornaments along with cash lying there.

As per the custody certificate placed on record, the petitioner has undergone two years four months and five days of the imprisonment as

on 09.07.2015. As other co-accused have already been allowed the benefit of regular bail, applying the principle of parity, the petitioner is also entitled to similar benefit of bail.

This petition is allowed.

The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Fazilka subject to following terms:-

1. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
2. In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh before the trial Court.
3. He shall not leave the country without previous permission of the Court.
