Petitioner, by way of instant petition filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.), seeks quashing of FIR No. 89, dated 19.07.2013 under Sections 498-A, 323 of the Indian Penal Code (for short "IPC"), registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur on the basis of compromise dated 26.02.2015.

When the parties were directed to appear before the learned Trial Court for getting their statements recorded in view of the compromise, they failed to appear. In view of the order dated 14.08.2015, the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate vide his report dated 25.08.2015 has reported that statements of the parties could not be recorded because of the non-settlement of terms of compromise between them.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for in the present case and the same is disposed of as such. However, liberty

is granted to the parties to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action, but only after the terms of settlement are finalized between them.

The instant petition stands disposed of.
