Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing sometime, seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to take all the pleas before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

However, keeping in view that the main allegation in the FIR is against the brother of the petitioner, personal appearance of petitioner before the trial Court is exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

(i) petitioner shall be represented through counsel; (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings; (iii) shall not dispute her identity as an accused; (iv) shall have no objection if, the prosecution evidence is recorded in her absence, but in the presence of her counsel; (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required; and (vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
