Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.6 dated 18.05.2015, under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13(1) (d) read with Section 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Ferozepur Range Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 13.07.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that entitlement of the petitioner as per jamabandi comes out to be 1/4th share of 25 kanals 2 marlas of land belonging to Arjun Singh. If necessary calculations are made, entitlement comes out to be 6 kanals 5 ½ marlas i.e. equivalent to 1129.5 sarsahis. Apparently, petitioner has sold 1065.5 sarsahis and therefore the area so sold is less than his actual entitlement.

Notice of motion for 28.7.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2)Cr.P.C. To be heard with CRM-M No. 20805 of 2015.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Inspector Baj Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 13.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
