The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.233, dated 14.5.2013, registered under Sections 148, 149, 216, 323, 325, 307, 120-B of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Civil Lines Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody since 27.10.2013 and that co-accused, namely, Jitender @ Sonu was granted bail by this Court vide order dated 10.11.2014 passed in CRM-M No.9901 of 2014.

Counsel for the respondent has argued that though the reasons which appealed to this Court for granting bail to the co-accused are not

irrelevant in the present case, but the fact is that the petitioner was the main accused.

In my considered opinion, the case of the present petitioner would have to be covered by the facts of the case of co-accused Jitender @ Sonu. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner in the same terms.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/CJM Bhiwani.

Petition stands disposed of.
