The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.76 dated 18.05.2014, registered under Sections 323, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka.

Heard.

The petitioner had sought an exemption from the hearing on 06.01.2015 but failed to appear before the trial Court on the adjourned hearing. The ground taken is that a wrong date was noted. Even thereafter, the petitioner failed to appear and arrest warrants had to be issued against her as service could not be effected. The bailable warrants issued to the surety were also

returned unserved. The trial has been held up. Had the plea been genuine, the petitioner would have approached the Court on the date noted by her. The petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court Judge/Duty Magistrate on 20.07.2015. She may avail the remedies which are available to her under law. No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
