This petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking protection to their life and liberty alleging that being major they have entered into matrimonial alliance against the wishes of private respondents, who are now posing threats to their life and liberty. The petitioners have alleged that date of birth of petitioner No.1 Parveen Kumari is 9.10.1992. In support of her contention she has placed on record copy of *adhar card* Annexure P-1. The date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 14.11.1990 as recorded in his passport, copy of which is annexure P-2. It is alleged that both the petitioners belong to same caste and their marriage has not gone down well with the private respondents.

Mr. Kapil Khanna, Advocate who has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.7 and 8 submits that petitioners are from the same clan as the grand father of the petitioners is same. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.7 and 8, on their instructions, submits that they will not interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioners. On the request of Mr. Kapil Khanna, Advocate, opportunity was also allowed to respondents No.7 and 8 to have talk with the petitioners in Court. However, parties could not reach any amicable settlement.

Without expressing any opinion on the validity of marriage of petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, to look into the representation of the petitioner No.1, copy of which is annexure P-4, on receipt of copy of this order along with copy of representation. It is made clear that nothing contained in this order shall have any bearing in the civil or criminal proceedings pending against the petitioners.
