Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Sujata alleging that she was married to petitioner in the year 2013 and maltreated by the petitioner.

The matter appears to have been compromised between the parties. Complainant and the petitioner have agreed to part company by filing an application under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act. Bank draft of Rs. 1 lac has been paid to the complainant in the Court today and an undertaking has been given on behalf of the petitioner that the remaining amount as per the terms of the compromise will be paid.

A photocopy of the compromise deed has been retained on the file.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. It is ordered that in

case of arrest of petitioner, he shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of arresting officer subject to following conditions:

- (i) that the petitioner will join investigation as and when required;
- (ii) that he will comply with the terms and conditions of the compromise.

In case of non-performance of obligations arising out of the compromise, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for cancellation of the bail.
